

**NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD & PUBLIC HEARING
MODIFICATION TO FY 2017 “OBO” NORTH EAST BOROUGH CDBG PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that North East Borough officials will hold a public hearing on Monday, June 18, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. at the North East Borough Municipal Building, located at 31 West Main Street, North East, PA 16428 for the purpose of a considering a proposal to “modify” the Borough’s FY 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.

The Borough received \$84,468 in FY 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding from the PADCED and previously resolved that the monies be used to undertake the following projects:

- \$46,582 - Multi-year funded Lincoln Street Sidewalk & Curb Replacement Project
- \$29,436 – Liberty Street and Bothel Street Water Line Replacement Project
- \$8,450 - Program Administration

It was anticipated that to undertake the Lincoln Street Sidewalk & Curb Replacement Project funding would be needed from FY’s 2015, 2016 and a portion of FY 2017. Bids on the project were recently opened and only FY 2015 and FY 2016 CDBG monies will be needed thus freeing up \$46,582 in FY 2017 funds to undertake another activity. Given this situation, the Borough proposes the following:

- Delete the Lincoln Street Sidewalks and Curb Replacement Project from the FY 2017 budget in favor of a new activity known as the South Washington Street Rehabilitation Project which would involve milling and placement of a bituminous surface on a portion of South Washington Street. The limits of work would begin at the intersection of SR 426 and head north along South Washington Street for approximately 1,100 feet to the south side of the Norfolk Southern Railroad tracks. Estimated cost is \$46,000.

All interested persons are encouraged to attend the hearing. Comments will be accepted until 4:30 PM the day prior to the hearing.

The meeting room where the hearing will be conducted is handicapped accessible.
